Two suicide attackers held in Helmand LASHKARGAH, Dec 28 (Pajhwok Afghan News): Two teenaged suspected suicide attackers were held in restive Helmand province, police said on Friday.

Helmand Police Chief Brig. Gen. Mohammad Hussain Andiwal told Pajhwok Afghan news that police had information since last five months that suicide attackers would enter Helmand province.

He said these two attackers along their jackets were arrested from a house in Sapian area of Lashkargah.

Helmand governor Asadullah Wafa said both the suspects were Pakistani national one Hamidullah and the other Ilm Gul.

He said they were the residents of Pishin and Qalat areas in Baluchistan province of Pakistan.

More than ten suicide attacks have taken place in Helmand province during 2007 killing tens of people.
